EVS Activity: - 'I am Responsible'

Dear Parents,

Waste management is one of the most crucial problems which our country is facing right now. India produces 62 million tonnes of waste each year. When we segregate waste, there is not only a reduction of waste that gets landfilled, it also reduces pollution levels by lowering the percentage of garbage exposed to air and water. Proper waste management is extremely important because it reduces the effect of pollution on the environment and nature. At school, we are training our students to use two different colour coded bins for- wet waste (green) and dry waste (blue). Kindly encourage the children to follow and incorporate the same at home. This habit will reduce the burden on the municipal authorities and workers to segregate the waste.





Who was Tenali Raman?


Tenali Raman was famous for his intelligence, wisdom, and quick thinking.

He was one of the eight poets at the court of **King Krishnadeva Raya**. He was known as **Vikatakavi** which means a **jester poet**.

A **jester is** someone who made people laugh with their jokes, funny stories, etc. King Krishnadeva Raya appointed Tenali as the court **jester**.



Who was Tenali Raman? Where did he live? What did he do? How did he reach the palace of King Krishnadeva Raya? Why was he famous?
